Role title	Handy Person / General Maintenance
Purpose of the role	The role of the handy person is to ensure that NOAH sites are kept to a good standard and repairs are completed in a timely manner, and that our buildings are safe and presentable to all people that use the services.
What you will be doing	 Helping with the general upkeep and maintenance of our sites Working alongside the site manager and other staff to ensure all works are completed and materials are ordered Working alongside the various departments to ensure each area is safe and secure for all staff. Assisting with various health and safety aspects such as PAT testing Painting the various areas of the building Undertaking basic repairs
Skills, experience and qualities needed	You will be able to work on your own initiative and manage your time to ensure that tasks and repairs are completed in a timely manner. You will be able to complete general maintenance and repairs. Any of the following would also be great to have: Experience of any building trades Working knowledge of plumbing Working knowledge of electrics
When and where	Volunteers are flexible and do not have a minimum commitment, actual dates and times will be agreed in advance. Available hours will generally be from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm, Monday to Friday.
Support offered	 You will be assigned a named staff member as a direct contact for any questions or queries you may have Training can be offered such as general maintenance, COSHH, manual handling, or anything related to the role All travel and incidental expenses will be covered (as agreed in advance)
What you could get out of it	 Experience of working with a charity Meeting new people in a very diverse range of activities Additional skills experience and training The satisfaction of knowing you have helped support someone that is either homeless or at risk of being homeless
Other relevant information	This role may require moderate physical effort
