Role title	Cleaner
Purpose of the role	The role of a cleaner is to ensure that the NOAH sites are cleaned to a good standard and presentable for when staff, visitors and service users arrive
What you will be doing	 Depending on the site, this may include: General cleaning of rooms Restocking supplies in toilets, showers and kitchen areas Working alongside staff members to ensure that cleaning supplies are ordered and replenished Ensuring COSHH is adhered to Emptying bins and cleaning the external areas
Skills, experience and qualities needed	You will be able to work on your own initiative and manage your own time to ensure each area is kept clean and tidy. You will be able to lift items as this role will require some manual handling. An understanding of COSHH would be beneficial but not essential as training can be provided
When and where	Volunteers are flexible and do not have a minimum commitment, actual dates and times will be agreed in advance. Available hours will generally be from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm, Monday to Friday.
Support offered	 You will be assigned a named staff member as a direct contact for any questions or queries you may have Training will be offered, such as COSHH or manual handling All travel and incidental expenses will be covered (as agreed in advance)
What you could get out of it	 Experience of working with a charity Meeting new people Additional skills experience The satisfaction of knowing you have helped support someone that is either homeless or at risk of being homeless by ensuring that they have a nice, clean and welcoming environment
Other relevant information	This role will require moderate physical effort.
