Purpose of the role	Our Outreach workers find and visit rough sleepers to offer prompt and effective support to move away from life on the streets.
What you will be doing	 Accompanying our NOAH Outreach workers, travelling to, and walking around towns, villages, and countryside to find rough sleepers Performing welfare checks on rough sleepers Interacting with rough sleepers
Skills, experience and qualities needed	 You will have care and compassion for the homeless, and good communication skills. You will have a non-judgemental approach, and be committed to understanding of the needs of those rough sleeping. Any of the following would be great to have: Knowledge of NOAH services Knowledge of issues surrounding homelessness Driving licence and own vehicle
When and where	Various locations and hours are available in Luton, and Central Bedfordshire. Please note that outreach shifts start from 5.00 or 6.00 am.
Support offered	 You will be assigned a named staff member as a direct contact for any questions or queries you may have Training and guidance will be offered in supporting rough sleepers All travel and incidental expenses will be covered (as agreed in advance)
What you could get out of it	 Experience of working with a charity Experience supporting vulnerable people which could lead to career opportunities Meeting new people Additional skills experience The satisfaction of knowing you have helped support someone that is either homeless or at risk of being homeless
