

Role title	NOAH Ambassador
Purpose of the role	To support NOAH Enterprise in promoting awareness of its services and work. Volunteers may help engage potential supporters or partners and attend events with prior agreement and guidance from staff.
What you will be doing	An Ambassador may undertake one or more of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supporting promotion of NOAH's work within personal or professional networks • Attending events or forums where agreed with staff • Identifying potential supporters or partnerships and referring them to staff • Supporting awareness or fundraising campaigns led by NOAH Enterprise • Supporting media or social media engagement only where authorised and briefed
Skills, experience and qualities needed	Volunteers are usually helpful if they are confident communicators or public speakers. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thorough knowledge of NOAH services • Knowledge of issues surrounding homelessness and poverty alleviation • Understanding of local authority services • Understanding of regulatory issues • Understanding of fundraising and marketing NOAH Enterprise welcomes volunteers from diverse backgrounds and will consider reasonable adjustments in line with the Equality Act 2010.
When and where	Volunteers can agree mutually convenient dates and times with staff. There is no obligation to provide a minimum number of hours.
Support offered	Relevant training, guidance and briefings will normally be provided where appropriate. Reasonable out-of-pocket expenses may be reimbursed in line with organisational procedures.
